# THE SPIRIT OF BOSTON CRUISE INFORMATION

# Attire. What is the dress code on the Spirit of Boston?

For evening cruises, appropriate attire is business casual to dressy. Men traditionally wear slacks and sport coats, with or without ties. Women wear dresses or nice pants. We do not recommend T-shirts, jeans, shorts or sneakers in the evening. Afternoon cruises are generally more relaxed, and casual attire is fine.

# Boarding. What is "Boarding Time" and "Cruising Time?"

"Boarding Time" is the earliest guests may board the ship. Typically boarding begins 1/2 hour prior to the "Cruise Time." Tickets may be picked up at the dockside kiosk up-to one hour prior to the cruise.

# Children. Are there any age requirements?

Children are welcome on almost all cruises.

# Coast Guard Regulations. Is the vessel Coast Guard certified?

Yes. The Spirit of Boston is Coast Guard certified and maintained regularly to adhere to strict safety regulations.

# Cruise Route. Where does the Spirit of Boston go?

The ship departs from the Seaport World Trade Center Marine Terminal in Boston. While sailing routes may vary, the Spirit of Boston cruises past the city skyline as far north as the Mystic River and as far south as Castle Island/ Fort Independence.

# Dancing. What kind of dance music is played?

Lunch and dinner cruises feature a full range of popular dance tunes spun by some of the city's hottest DJs. Selections may include Rock, Blues, Line Dances, Motown, Oldies, Salsa, Hip Hop, Country, and current chart-toppers from every musical genre.

# Directions. How do I get to the ship?

The Spirit of Boston is located at the intersection of Seaport Boulevard and B Street adjacent to Boston's World Trade Center and across from the Seaport Hotel.

# Drinks. What do drinks cost?

Mixed drinks start at \$7 for standard brand liquors, \$8.25 for premium drinks. Specialty cocktails start at \$9 and frozen drinks at \$9.75. All beer is sold by the bottle, with domestic beer for \$5.50 and imported for \$5.75. Wine begins at \$8 per glass. Soft drinks and juice are available for \$2 each. These prices do not include tax or gratuity and are subject to change.

# Entertainment. What type of entertainment is offered?

It begins with streamers and a Bon Voyage celebration at your table. Intermittent live song performances as well as subtle background music will accompany the dining portion of your cruise. After dessert, star-quality performers stage a live song-and-dance revue, followed by pulsing dance hits played by some of the city's hottest DJs.

# Gratuity. Is gratuity included in the ticket price?

A service charge is included in the price and covers gratuity on the food portion of the ticket price. It does not include any gratuity for beverages purchased on the ship or for any outstanding personal service provided by your server.

# Groups. What size group can Spirit of Boston accommodate?

The Spirit of Boston can host up to 600 guests. Parties of 20 or more should contact our group sales department at 866-973-7436.

# Handicap accessibility. Is the ship handicap accessible? Yes.



# Parking. Is there parking close to the ship?

Yes. The Seaport Hotel Parking Garage is just a short walk from the Spirit of Boston, and offers discounted parking for Spirit guests as follows: Complimentary parking Monday through Friday evenings - you must enter the garage after 5PM and exit prior to 11PM and bring your boarding pass when you leave to receive free parking. For all other Spirit cruises, the garage offers 35% off the posted hotel garage rates. Your Spirit of Boston boarding pass is necessary to receive this discount. There are also outdoor parking lots on Northern Avenue and Seaport Boulevard that do not offer discounts. Parking rates there vary from \$7 to \$10 per day.

# Seasickness. Will I get seasick?

It is highly unlikely. The Spirit of Boston sails in the calm waters of the inner harbor and outer islands. The ship does not go out into open ocean water.

# Seating. How is seating arranged on board?

Ships feature cabaret-style seating. The majority of tables accommodate four to eight people and guests are sometimes seated with other parties.

# Ship Information. Can you tell me a little about the ship?

The Spirit of Boston is spaciously designed with three climate-controlled interior decks, outdoor strolling decks at the bow and stern, and the largest outdoor patio deck in Boston topside. It is handicap accessible and Coast Guard approved for up to 600 passengers. Amenities include full service bars, two dance floors (or staging areas), spacious bathrooms, flexible seating arrangements and huge, panoramic windows.

# Smoking. What is the smoking policy?

All interior areas of the ship are non-smoking areas. Passengers who smoke may do so on the outdoor observation decks.

# Tickets. Where can I pick up the cruise tickets?

Tickets can be conveniently picked up at the dock up to one hour prior to the cruise. Photo ID will be required.

# DIRECTIONS

# FROM POINTS NORTH VIA I-93:

- Heading southbound on Interstate 93 Boston, take Exit 23, Purchase Street and move into the left lane.
- At the top of the ramp, take a left turn onto the Evelyn Moakley Bridge/Seaport Boulevard.
- Follow Seaport Boulevard for approximately .8 miles.
- The Seaport Boulevard entrance to the Seaport Garage will be on the right, after the Seaport Boulevard/B Street intersection.
- The Spirit of Boston is docked at the Seaport World Trade Center at Commonwealth Pier.

# FROM POINTS SOUTH VIA I-93:

- Heading northbound on I-93 towards Boston, take Exit 20, which will be immediately after Exit 18.
- Follow the signs to "I-90 East." Take the first tunnel exit, Exit 25, to "South Boston."
- At the first set of lights at the top of the ramp, proceed straight onto East Service Road.
- At the next set of lights, take a right onto Seaport Boulevard. The Seaport Boulevard entrance to the Seaport Garage will be on the right, after the Seaport Boulevard/B Street intersection.
- The Spirit of Boston is docked at the Seaport World Trade Center at Commonwealth Pier.

# FROM POINTS WEST VIA STORROW DRIVE:

- Take Storrow Drive East to Leverett Circle and follow signs for Interstate 93 South/Logan Airport.
- Once on Interstate 93 South, follow directions from "Points North".

# POINTS WEST VIA I-90:

- Follow the Massachusetts Turnpike/Interstate 90 East to Exit 25 South Boston.
- At the top of the ramp, bear left towards Seaport Boulevard.
- At the first set of lights, proceed straight onto East Service Road.
- At the next set of lights, take a right onto Seaport Boulevard.
- The Seaport Boulevard entrance to the Seaport Garage will be on the right, after the Seaport Boulevard/B Street intersection.
- The Spirit of Boston is docked at the Seaport World Trade Center at Commonwealth Pier.

# FROM LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND ROUTE 1A SOUTH:

- Follow the signs towards I-90 West Ted Williams Tunnel.
- Take the Ted Williams Tunnel to Exit 25.
- At the top of the ramp proceed straight onto B Street. Follow B Street to the end and take a right onto Seaport Boulevard.
- The Seaport Boulevard entrance to the Seaport Garage will be on the right, after the Seaport Boulevard/B Street intersection.
- The Spirit of Boston is docked at the Seaport World Trade Center at Commonwealth Pier.

# **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:**

- From South Station, take the MBTA Silver Line Waterfront (one level above the Red Line, one below the food court) to World Trade Center Station.
- Take the stairs/escalators/elevators to the second level and exit onto World Trade Center Ave.
- The Seaport Hotel will be ahead on the right.
